#### Conclusion

The MAX1115 successfully meets the quality and reliability standards required of all Maxim products. In addition, Maxim's continuous reliability monitoring program ensures that all outgoing product will continue to meet Maxim's quality and reliability standards.

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### I. Device Description

#### A. General

The MAX1115 low-power, 8-bit, analog-to-digital converter (ADC) features an internal track/hold (T/H), voltage reference,  $V_{DD}$  monitor, clock, and serial interface. The MAX1115 is specified from +2.7V to +5.5V. The part consumes only 175 $\mu$ A at 100ksps.

The full-scale analog input range is determined by the internal reference of +2.048 The MAX1115 also features AutoShutdown<sup>TM</sup> power-down mode which reduces power consumption to <1µA when the device is not in use. The 3-wire serial interface directly connects to SPI<sup>TM</sup>, QSPI<sup>TM</sup>, and MICROWIRE<sup>TM</sup> devices without external logic. Conversions up to 100ksps are performed using an internal clock.

Rating

The MAX1115 is available in an 8-pin SOT23 package with a footprint that is just 30% of an 8-pin SO.

### VI. Reliability Evaluation

### A. Accelerated Life Test

The results of the 135°C biased (static) life test are shown in **Table 1**. Using these results, the Failure Rate ( $\lambda$ ) is calculated as follows:

This low failure rate represents data collected from Maxim's reliability monitor program. In addition to routine production Burn-In, Maxim pulls a sample from every fabrication process three times per week and subjects it to an extended Burn-In prior to shipment to ensure its reliability. The reliability control level for each lot to be shipped as standard product is 59 F.I.T. at a 60% confidence level, which equates to 3 failures in an 80 piece sample. Maxim performs failure analysis on any lot that exceeds this reliability control level. Attached Burn-In Schematic (Spec. # 06-5604) shows the static Burn-In circuit. Maxim also performs quarterly 1000 hour life test monitors. This data is published in the Product Reliability Report (RR-1M).

#### B. Moisture Resistance Tests

Maxim pulls pressure pot samples from every assembly process three times per week. Each lot sample must meet an LTPD = 20 or less before shipment as standard product. Additionally, the industry standard 85°C/85%RH testing is done per generic device/package family once a quarter.

# C. E.S.D. and Latch-Up Testing

The AC22-4 die type has been found to have all pins able to withstand a transient pulse of  $\pm 2000$ V per Mil-Std-883 Method 3015 (reference attached ESD Test Circuit). Latch-Up testing has shown that this device withstands a current of  $\pm 250$ mA.





# 3.4 Pin combinations to be tested.

- a. Each pin individually connected to terminal A with respect to the device ground pin(s) connected to terminal B. All pins except the one being tested and the ground pin(s) shall be open.
- b. Each pin individually connected to terminal A with respect to each different set of a combination of all named power supply pins (e.g., \( \lambda\_{S1} \), or \( \lambda\_{S2} \) or \( \lambda\_{S3} \) or \( \lambda\_{CC1} \), or \( \lambda\_{CC2} \)) connected to terminal B. All pins except the one being tested and the power supply pin or set of pins shall be open.
- c. Each input and each output individually connected to terminal A with respect to a combination of all the other input and output pins connected to terminal B. All pins except the input or output pin being tested and the combination of all the other input and output pins shall be open.
